How To **Blue Print Fabric for Beginners**



Get Started What You'll Need



PB080 Specialist Crafts Blue Print Fabric CR139 **Urchins & Starfish** Pack

B086A099 Coloured Laces Pack of 10

Step by Step LET'S CREATE



Remove one piece of fabric from the light-proof bag and place it onto a flat piece of cardboard.



Place your chosen objects on top of the fabric and, if necessary, pin them into place to keep the objects from moving.



Carefully carry the cardboard outside or by a large window directly facing the sunlight. You can also expose Blue Print Fabric to ultraviolet light however, test the exposure time on a scrap of fabric before carrying out the print.



That's it, your blue print fabric piece is complete!



Take the Blue Print Fabric indoors and remove all the design pieces. Do not remove the pieces while the fabric is still in the sun. The final colour will not show until the square is rinsed and dried. Rinse your Blue Print Fabric in tepid water, repeat this until the water runs clear.
